

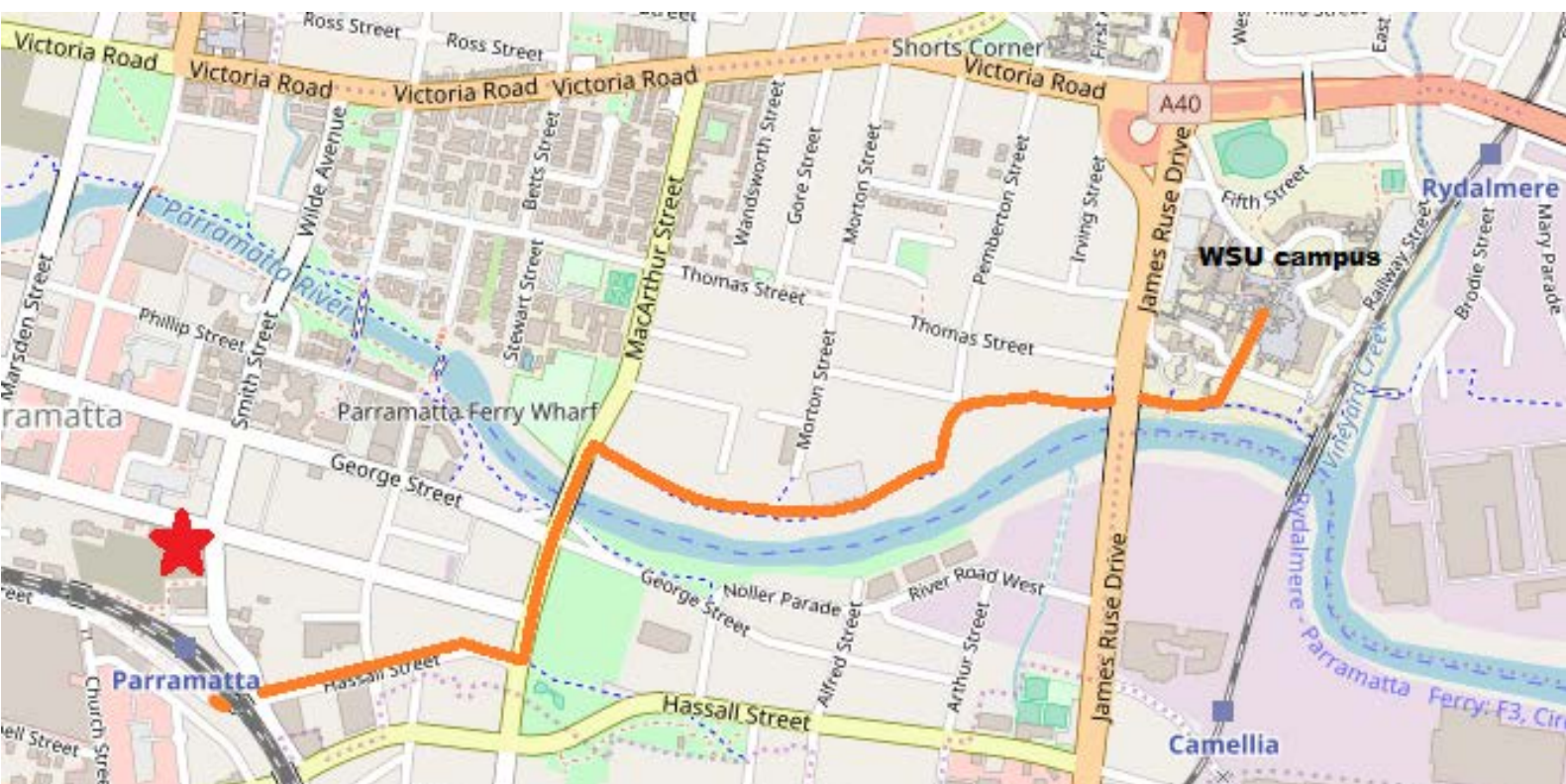


Parramatta is located 30 minutes by train away from central Sydney. To the left is a map showing key locations and train lines.

In order to use Sydney public transport, you will need an [Opal card](#). These can be obtained at major train stations (including the airport stations) and convenience stores, and will enable you to use buses, trains, light rail and ferries.

The State Library (site of the opening reception) is situated on the [north-east side of central Sydney](#), on Macquarie Street just below the Botanic Gardens (a 10 minute walk from Circular Quay).

Western Sydney University Parramatta South campus is a pleasant 25 to 30-minute walk along the river from Parramatta Station/City (see map below, route marked in orange). There is also a free [shuttle bus](#) that leaves from the Parramatta City campus, near Parramatta Station (location marked with a red star).



Other options for getting to Parramatta South campus include:

- [Ferry](#) from Circular Quay Wharf to Rydalmere Wharf (+ 20 min river walk)
- Public [bus](#) from Parramatta Train Station, Strathfield Train Station or Circular Quay Train Station (the last option takes a long time)
- [Taxi/Uber](#) from either Sydney city (which would be quite expensive...) or Parramatta City.
